# **Secondary Metals Recycler Registration Form**

Pursuant to O.C.G.A. 10-1-360, beginning July 1, 2012, secondary metals recyclers who purchase regulated metal property in any quantity must register with the appropriate sheriff's office or offices.

### **To Determine the County of Registration**

# • Business (Corporation or Partnership)

If you registering as a *business*, you must register with the sheriff in each county where you maintain a place of business. If you maintain a place of business in more than one county, you must file a separate registration form for each business location.

## • Individual (Sole Proprietor)

If you are registering as an *individual*, you must register in the county where you reside.

# • Non-resident of Georgia

If you are <u>not a resident</u> of Georgia, you must register in the county where you primarily engage or intend to engage in the business as a secondary metals recycler.

### **The Registration Process**

- Obtain a copy of the *Secondary Metals Recycler Registration* form by online at <a href="https://www.hartcountyga.gov">www.hartcountyga.gov</a> or by visiting the Hart County Sheriff's Office website <a href="https://sheriff.hartcountyga.gov">sheriff.hartcountyga.gov</a>.
- Complete and submit the registration form *in person* to the appropriate sheriff's office or offices.
- Application for registration must include:

### \*Non Refundable Registration Fee

Submit payment of \$200 with the registration form; the payment must be made by check or money order payable to the Hart County Sheriff's Office. Checks returned for insufficient funds are subject to a \$30 service charge pursuant to O.C.G.A. 16-9-20

### \*Identification

# \*Citizenship /Qualified Alien Status

If you are a qualified alien, your Secure and Verifiable documentation must be attached to the application.

• Read the instructions carefully and be familiar with the laws governing Secondary Metals Recyclers in the State of Georgia. Visit our website for information.

### Registration

Each registration is valid for a 12 month period beginning with the effective registration date as established by the sheriff's office once all registration requirements are met.

Attach registration fee: \$200 (Non-refundable). The fee for checks returned due to insufficient funds is \$30. Provide a copy of your identification.

The period of registration shall be for one year. A new registration form and annual fee must be submitted to the sheriff of the county where the business is located or the individual resides by the expiration date of the preceding year. If the person fails to register annually on or before the date of registration, he/she shall be guilty of a misdemeanor of a high and aggravated nature.
